General information about the dangers of irregular maintenance

Glass can handle a lot – but not everything! The effects of increasing extreme weather phenomena like storms, heavy rainfall, hail, snow and ice can present a real danger for complex glass structures in the long run.

The persistent effects of weather can lead to changes, material fatigue and wear and tear in building components. The result: water penetration and expensive consequential damages through cracks, detached screw fittings and leakage points.

Regular and professional maintenance remedies this, taking the safety of working on the roof into consideration.

Why regular maintenance is so important

- professional cleaning of glass surfaces at regular intervals increases the service life
- regular maintenance prevents the damaging ingress of water into the building structure
- danger of structural damage to the load-bearing glass construction is significantly reduced
- risk of building or machine standstills due to repairs is effectively prevented
- avoidance of high capital and personnel outlay in the event
- maintenance and upkeep ensure the long-term value retention of the construction and, therefore, the entire property
- maintenance fee as a fixed, planned expense

Check all screw fittings for proper fit

Retighten of loose screw fittings

Examine all moulding and metal sheets for correct fit

Assess the glass panels for cracking

Clean accumulated dirt, to ensure correct water drainage (no glass cleaning)

Examine all seals and sealants

- maintenance work certified in accordance with DIN EN ISO 9001
